Dear Parkcrest Club Member,

Parkcrest Swim and Tennis Club season is fast approaching! You'll note this packet is significantly lighter than usual. In an effort to reduce costs and save a few trees, the board of directors decided this year to make the standard packet available online. We have tried to make things easy to find but if you are having trouble finding something, send me or any other board member an e-mail and we will direct you to it. We do have a limited number of hard copies of the packet so please call the pool at 233-3573 and leave a message, including name, address and phone number, on the membership line if you need one.

The pool will be open for the summer on Saturday, May 29th. Please note that the All Activities Sign Up is set for Sunday, June 6th. Also, the spring clean-up is set for Sunday, May 2nd. Please plan to come and help out. Your family will receive 5 free guest passes if you do.

We are very pleased that our pool manager, Tim Ritchie, is returning for a third season. He has put together a great staff and is looking forward to another great summer at PC.

As usual, we have many fun and exciting events taking place this summer, including:

- Basketball Tournament, Saturday, May 22nd.
- Trivia Night, Saturday, June 19th.
- Totally Teen Night, Tuesday, June 29th.
- Family Float-In Ice Cream Social, Tuesday, July 6th.
- Adult Social/ Silent Auction, Saturday, July 10th.
- Adult Penguin Invitational Swim Meet, July 17th.
- PC Penguin Pajama Party & Movie Night, Sunday, September 5th.
- Doggie Dip, Monday, September 6th.

Please consider volunteering to help out for these events as we need all the help we can get. Swim and dive team families should review all of the team forms to be aware of volunteer expectations and season information.

The programs offered by the club are similar to last year. Lessons this summer will be in two four-week sessions as they have been the past few summers. Further information on the various programs is available on the website.

Dues for stockholding members are the same as 2009 although hopefully the dues statement will create less confusion. As always, financial information is available upon request and at the pool during the summer.

A quick summary of the club's financial situation shows:

- Parkcrest generated positive cash flow of approximately \$25,000 last year - \$16,700 of which was the special assessment revenue collected to support capital improvements, which were financed upfront via additional borrowing.
- Our current mortgage liability is \$340,769.
- The 2010 budget reflects positive cash flow of approximately \$19,000. This budget includes incremental expenses for:
 - Drain cover replacement on all three pools as a result of new code requirements- \$5,000.
 - New siding for snack shack and manager office - \$6,000
 - New covered, dry-erase bulletin boards - \$2,700
 - New exterior pool speakers - \$2,000
 - New chairs (5) and chaise lounges (5) - \$1,550 (this will become an annual item to replenish over time)
- Minimum wage increases over the last few years have been absorbed as losses to the pool rather than increasing membership dues. For 2010, we have made some adjustments to coverage of the snack shack with guards covering most of the hours thus reducing labor costs. For 2011, we'll revisit this approach.

The 2010 Membership Dues are attached to this letter. All dues are to be paid by May 15, 2010, and must be paid before you can register for programs or lessons. If dues are paid by May 1, 2010, you will receive five free guest passes. I want to remind you that there is a *late payment fee* of \$35.00 for dues that are not paid by May 15th. Please make checks payable to **Parkcrest Swim and Tennis Club, Inc.** and send them in the enclosed envelope.

Feel free to contact any Board member if you have questions. Board members (and their phone numbers) are identified in the program materials. Also, be sure to check out the pool website, www.parkcrestpool.com, for additional information. By calling 233-3573, you can find out the status of swim/dive team practice, lessons or leave a message for our membership coordinator, Peter Olson. You should also leave a message for Peter Olson at this number if you know of someone who is looking to become a member or if you wish to sell your stock or are considering "inactive" status.

Inactive Stock Maintenance Fee. Fee for inactive stockowners. No pool or court usage, no lessons, no swim/dive teams, no water ballet. \$445*

Summer Family Membership. Includes use of the pool during open swim and adult swim and use of courts during non-lesson/program times. Also, includes swimming and diving lessons (at no additional charge), tennis lessons, swim and/or dive teams, and water ballet. \$770*

Summer Couple or Individual Membership. Includes use of the pool during open swim and adult swim and use of courts during non-lesson/program times. No swimming, diving or tennis lessons, no swim or dive team, no water ballet. \$620*

Summer Recreational Family Membership Includes use of the pool during open swim and adult swim and use of courts during non-lesson/program times. No swimming, diving or tennis lessons, no swim or dive team, no water ballet. \$620*

Individual Membership New Member (age 14 & up): Includes use of the pool during open swim and adult swim and use of courts during non-lesson/program times. Swim/Dive teams and water ballet also available. \$375
